ROAD TRAFFIC

The A50 Trunk Road (Longton, Stoke on Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 5th December 2011

Coming into force - - 12th December 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads at Longton in the City of Stoke on Trent, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A50 Trunk Road (Longton, Stoke on Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12 December 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A50 at its roundabout junction with Baths Road and Foley Road, Longton;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading –

- i) to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from the roundabout; and
- ii) from the eastbound carriageway of the A50 to the roundabout;

“a link road” means –

- i) the westbound link road leading from the A5035 Trentham Road Roundabout to the roundabout; and

- ii) the eastbound link road leading from the roundabout to the A5007/Normacot Road Roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Thursday 15th December 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the roundabout, a slip road or a link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
