ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A282 Trunk Road (Junctions 1A & 1B, Slip Roads)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *19th December 2011*
Coming into force - - *14th January 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A282 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A282 Trunk Road (Junctions 1A & 1B, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 14th January 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A282 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

“a slip road” means-

- (i) the road leading to the anti-clockwise carriageway of the trunk road from the A206 at Junction 1A, or
- (ii) the road leading to the anti-clockwise carriageway of the trunk road from the A296/A225 at Junction 1B;

“works” means sign installation work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2100 hours on Monday 16th January 2012 or on any subsequent day until 13th July 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
