ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (Kettle O’Fish Roundabout – Fishmarket Road Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *19th December 2011*

Coming into force - - *6th January 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Kettle O’Fish Roundabout – Fishmarket Road Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 6th January 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road at Rye in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road (Strand Quay, South Undercliff and Fishmarket Road) between the Kettle O’Fish roundabout (Wish Street) and Fishmarket Road roundabout (A268);

“works” means resurfacing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 47 hours starting at 0600 hours on Saturday 7th January 2012 or on any subsequent Saturday until 29th June 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or

- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
