ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (Little Common Road) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011

Made - - - - - *7th February 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *26th February 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Little Common Road) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 26th February 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road (Little Common Road) at Bexhill in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 140 metres west of Broadoak Lane and 50 metres east of Sutherland Avenue (B2098);

“works” mean the construction of a central island and signing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Tuesday 1st March 2011 or on any subsequent day until 25th August 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
