ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A14 Trunk Road (Junctions with the A5199 and A508,
Northamptonshire) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of
Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *4th February 2011*

Coming into force - - *11th February 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads in the County of Northamptonshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junctions with the A5199 and A508, Northamptonshire) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 11th February 2011.

2. In this Order –

| “a slip road” | means the slip road leading –

(i) from and to the eastbound carriageway of the A14 at its junction with the A5199 (Junction 1); and

(ii) from and to the eastbound carriageway of the A14 at its junction with the A508 (Junction 2); |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 14 February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
