**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A63 Trunk Road (Mytongate Gyratory to Daltry Street Interchange and Garrison Road Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *9th February 2011*

*Coming into force* - *20th February 2011*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A63 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Kingston upon Hull, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, signing and lining works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A63 Trunk Road (Mytongate Gyratory to Daltry Street Interchange and Garrison Road Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 20th February 2011.

2. In this Order; –

“the A63” means the A63 Trunk Road;

“the westbound carriageway” means the A63 westbound carriageway from its junction with the A1079 Mytongate Gyratory to the nose of the westbound entry slip road at Daltry Street Interchange, a distance of 1400 metres.

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A1079 Mytongate Gyratory;

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 21st February 2011 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the westbound carriageway or the roundabout.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A63:

(i) at its junction with St. James Street; or

(ii) circulatory carriageway, Garrison Road Roundabout, at its junction with Plimsoll Way.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the A63 circulatory carriageway, Garrison Road Roundabout, at its junction with Plimsoll Way.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) any person engaged or assisting in the said works or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.

and nothing in article 4 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A63 to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
