**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road (Flamstead, Hertfordshire) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *11th February 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - - *25th February 2011*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Flamstead, Hertfordshire) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 25th February 2011.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on a length of the A5 Trunk Road in the District of Dacorum in the County of Hertfordshire between points 150 metres north of the centre line of its junction with River Hill, Flamstead and 150 metres south of the centre line of its junction with London Road, Markyate a distance of 1172 metres.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order will impose a speed limit of 50 miles per hour to the A5 Trunk Road where, by virtue of the existence of street lighting, the speed limit has previously been restricted to 30 miles per hour.
