ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A43 Trunk Road (Silverstone, Northamptonshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - 14th February 2011

Coming into force - - 21st February 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A43 Trunk Road (“the A43”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads at Silverstone in the County of Northamptonshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A43 Trunk Road (Silverstone, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 21st February 2011.

2. In this Order:

| “the trunk road” | means the northbound carriageway of the A43 from its junction with slip road leading to the A413, Brackley Road (south of Silverstone) to its junction with the slip road leading from the A413 (north of Silverstone); |
| “a slip road” | means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A43 from –

(i) Dadford Road (south of Silverstone); and

(ii) the A413 (north of Silverstone); |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 28th February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
