ROAD TRAFFIC

The A52 Trunk Road (Brian Clough Way, Derby) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - - *18th February 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *25th February 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on five of those connecting roads in the City of Derby should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Brian Clough Way, Derby) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 25th February 2011.

2. In this Order –

“a link road” means the link road leading-

- (i) from the westbound carriageway of the A52 to the southbound carriageway of the A5111 Raynesway; and
- (ii) to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from the northbound carriageway of the A5111 Raynesway;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading-

- (i) to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its roundabout junction with the A6005;
- (ii) from the westbound carriageway of the A52 to its roundabout junction with the A6005; and
- (iii) from the eastbound carriageway of the A52 to Lodge Lane;

“the works period” means the period starting at 2000 hours on Monday 28th February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a link road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
