**The M1 Motorway and the A5 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 18)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - 28th February 2011

Coming into force - - 7th March 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”), the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that trunk road and four of those connecting roads near Crick, in the County of Northamptonshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway and the A5 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 18) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

| “the roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A5 at its junction with the M1/A428 (M1 Junction 18); |
| “the trunk road” | means the eastbound and westbound carriageway of the A5 between its junction with the roundabout and its roundabout junction with the A5/A428 west of M1 Junction 18; |
| “a slip road” | means the slip road leading –
<ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) from the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 18;(ii) from the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 18;(iii) to the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 18;(iv) to the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 18; |

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 14th March 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed.

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the roundabout, the trunk road or a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the east side of the roundabout at its junction with the A428.

5. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
