**The M6 Motorway (Junctions 38 – 37 Southbound
Carriageway) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *11th March 2011*

Coming into force - - *15th March 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway is satisfied that traffic on a section of that motorway in the District of Eden in the County of Cumbria should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junctions 38 – 37 Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 15th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M6 Motorway between Junctions 38 and 37;

“the length of carriageway” means a section of the southbound carriageway of the motorway from the last point where the Junction 38 entry slip road joins the carriageway of the motorway to the last point where the Junction 37 exit slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway;

“the works period” means three nights between 2000 hours and 0600 hours during a period starting on Wednesday 16 March 2011 and ending on Saturday 19 March 2011. However, works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.

“works” means road marking renewal works on the motorway.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven in the length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance
