**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A30 Trunk Road (Woodleigh Junction Eastbound Exit Slip Road, Near Cheriton Bishop, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *12 January 2011*

*Coming into force* - - *15 January 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at Woodleigh Junction near Cheriton Bishop, in the District of Teignbridge in the County of Devon, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Woodleigh Junction Eastbound Exit Slip Road, Near Cheriton Bishop, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 15 January 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the slip road” means the eastbound exit slip road at the A30 Woodleigh Junction;

“the works” mean resurfacing and associated works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 17 January 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works, for traffic officer purposes or for winter maintenance purposes.
