ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1 Trunk Road (Tinwell, Rutland) (Temporary Prohibition
of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *10th April 2012*

Coming into force - - *17th April 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads, at Tinwell in the County of Rutland, should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Tinwell, Rutland) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 17th April 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this order, no person shall, during the period starting at 15:00 hours on Friday 20th April 2012 and during the period starting at 15:00 hours on Tuesday 3rd July 2012 and for both periods ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this order, drive any motor vehicle on the slip road -

- (i) leading from the northbound carriageway of the A1 to the A6121; and
- (ii) leading from the southbound carriageway of the A1 to the A6121.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
