ROAD TRAFFIC

The M42 Motorway (Junctions 4 to 5) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 16th April 2012

 Coming into force
 23rd April 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junctions 4 to 5) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 23rd April 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the motorway" means the northbound carriageway of the M42 from a

point 700 metres north of its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 4 to a point 900 metres south of its

junction with the exit slip road at Junction 6;

"the Regulations" means the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales)

Regulations 1982(b);

"a hard shoulder" means the hard shoulder, within the meaning of

Regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations, which is adjacent

to the motorway;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22.30 hours on Monday 30th

April 2012 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
 - (iii) being used in connection with the said works; or
 - (iv) being used by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
- **5.** During the works period, regulations 5 and (in so far as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended in respect of a hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
