ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - - *16th April 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *23rd April 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 23rd April 2012.

2. In this Order:

- “a slip road” means –
- (i) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A38 from the A5121 at Claymills;
 - (ii) the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A38 to the A5121 at Claymills;
 - (iii) the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A38 to the A513 at Alrewas;
 - (iv) the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A38 to the roundabout junction with the A5148/A5206, near Lichfield; and
 - (v) the entry and exit slip roads leading to and from the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A38 at the Hilliards Cross (Wood end/Brookhay lane) junction;

“the works period” means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 30th April 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
