The M54 Motorway and the A5 Trunk Road (Telford to Shrewsbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 23rd April 2012

 Coming into force
 30th April 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M54 Motorway ("the M54"), the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads and one of those connecting roads, between Telford and Shrewsbury in the County of Shropshire and the Council of Telford and Wrekin, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M54 Motorway and the A5 Trunk Road (Telford to Shrewsbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 30th April 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the motorway" means the westbound carriageway of M54 between its

junction with the exit slip road at Junction 7 and its

junction with the A5;

"the trunk road" means the westbound carriageway of the of the A5 from

its junction with the M54 to its roundabout junction with

the A49 (Preston Roundabout);

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway

of the M54 at Junction 7;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 7th

May 2012 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway, the trunk road or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works, or by a traffic officer in uniform.
