ROAD TRAFFIC

The A36 Trunk Road (Salisbury to Alderbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - *8th May 2012*

Coming into force - - *14th May 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Alderbury in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Salisbury to Alderbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 14th May 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the A36” means (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A36 near Alderbury between its junction with Clarendon Road (the old A36) and the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the Grinstead Road Junction, Whaddon; and (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A36 near Alderbury between the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the Grinstead Road Junction, Whaddon and its junction with Clarendon Road (the old A36);

“tip of the nosing” means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

“the works” mean resurfacing, studs and road marking works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 16th May 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the A36.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
