ROAD TRAFFIC

The A31 Trunk Road (Canford Bottom Roundabout) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012

Made - - - - *21st May 2012*
Coming into force - - *1st June 2012*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A31 Trunk Road (Canford Bottom Roundabout) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st June 2012.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of the A31 Trunk Road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The A31 Trunk Road (Canford Bottom Roundabout) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 1999(b) is hereby revoked.

Length of the Trunk Road subject to a speed limit of 40 miles per hour

Both carriageways of the A31 Trunk Road in the District of East Dorset in the County of Dorset from a point 310 metres northeast of the edge of Canford Bottom roundabout to a point 10 metres southwest of the centreline of Old Ham Lane underbridge, a total distance of approximately 710 metres, including the carriageways through the roundabout and the roundabout itself.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order imposes a 40mph speed limit on an extended length of both carriageways of the A31 Trunk Road at Canford Bottom. The existing 40mph Speed Limit Order is revoked.
