ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A417 Trunk Road (Brockworth to Air Balloon Roundabout,
Crickley Hill, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of
Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *6th June 2012*

Coming into force - - *9th June 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A417 Trunk Road (“the A417”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads in the District of Tewkesbury in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A417 Trunk Road (Brockworth to Air Balloon Roundabout, Crickley Hill, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th June 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the A417” means the A417 at Crickley Hill from a point 650 metres south of the centre of Brockworth overbridge to its junction with the Air Balloon Roundabout;

“the slip roads” means (i) the southbound entry slip road at the A46 Shurdington Road Junction; and (ii) the northbound exit slip road at the A46 Shurdington Road Junction;

“the works” mean drainage and routine maintenance works (including gully emptying, lining, studs, litter picking and grass cutting);

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 11th June 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A417 and the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (d) a vehicle proceeding to and from premises that are accessible from and only from the A417.
