ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A38 Trunk Road (Clay Mills, Staffordshire) (Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 18th June 2012

Coming into force - - 25th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, at Clay Mills in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Clay Mills, Staffordshire) (Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 25th June 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3, no person shall, during the period starting at 06:00 hours on Saturday 30th June 2012 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this order, drive any motor vehicle on the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A38 to the A5121 at Clay Mills.

3. The provisions of article 2 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
