ROAD TRAFFIC

The A45 Trunk Road (Festival Island, Coventry) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 18th June 2012

Coming into force - - 25th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road and on three of those connecting roads, in the City of Coventry, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Festival Island, Coventry) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 25th June 2012.

2. In this Order:

| “the roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway at the roundabout junction of the A45, the A46 and the A444, known as Festival Island; |
| “the first length of the roundabout” | means that length of the roundabout between the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A444 and the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A444; |
| “a slip road” | means the slip road leading –
<ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) from the eastbound carriageway of the A45 to the roundabout ;(ii) from the westbound carriageway of the A45 to the roundabout; and(iii) to the eastbound carriageway of the A45 from the roundabout; |

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Thursday 28th June 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of the roundabout or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(iii) being used in connection with the said works.
