**The A452 and the A446 Trunk Roads (Coleshill, Warwickshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - 25th June 2012
Coming into force - - 2nd July 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A452 Trunk Road (“the A452”) and the A446 Trunk Road (“the A446”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads, south of Coleshill in the County of Warwickshire and the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A452 and the A446 Trunk Roads (Coleshill, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 2nd July 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means –

- (i) the northbound carriageway of the A452 from its roundabout junction with the A45 to its roundabout junction with the B4438/Solihull Parkway/A446;
- (ii) the southbound carriageway of the A452 from its roundabout junction with the B4438/Solihull Parkway/A446 to its roundabout junction with the A45; and
- (iii) the southbound carriageway of the A446 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A452/B4438/Solihull Parkway to the merge point with the A452;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 9th July 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
