**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Streethay, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 22nd June 2012

*Coming into force* - - 29th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Streethay near Lichfield in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Streethay, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 29th June 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3, no person shall, during the period starting at 08:00 hours on Saturday 30th June 2012 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this order, drive any motor vehicle on the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A38 to the A5127 Burton Road.

3. The provisions of article 2 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
