ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M58 Motorway (Junction 5, Eastbound Entry Slip Roads
from the A577 Northbound and Southbound) (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *17th July 2012*
Coming into force - - *19th July 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M58 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those slip roads in the District of West Lancashire in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M58 Motorway (Junction 5, Eastbound Entry Slip Roads from the A577 Northbound and Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 19th July 2012.

2. In this Order;

“the motorway” means the M58 Motorway;

“works” means geotechnical investigations on the motorway slip roads;

“the works period” means one weekend between 2200 hours on Friday and 0500 hours on Monday during a period starting on Friday 20 July 2012 and ending on Monday 13 August 2012. However, work may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the first slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 5 from the A577 northbound;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 5 from the A577 southbound.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first and second slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
