The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Road Cycle Event, Leatherhead, Surrey) (Amendment) Regulations 2012

Made - - - - - *6th July 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *7th July 2012*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Leatherhead, Surrey, by reason of the intended holding of certain London Olympic and Paralympic Games' events that are scheduled to take place there on 28th and 29th July 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Road Cycle Event, Leatherhead, Surrey) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 7th July 2012.

Amendment of Regulations

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Road Cycle Event, Leatherhead, Surrey) Regulations 2012(b) are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 3(4)(f), for the words “Runway 06” substitute “Runway 07”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Road Cycle Event, Leatherhead, Surrey) Regulations 2012 (S.I. 2012/1338) to correct the runway heading at Blackbushe Airport in regulation 3(4)(f).

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
