**The A38 Trunk Road (Barton-under-Needwood, Staffordshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.3) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 30th July 2012

Coming into force - - 6th August 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, north of Barton under Needwood in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Barton-under-Needwood, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.3) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 6th August 2012.

2. In this Order –

“Barton Service Road” means the service road adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A38, Lichfield Road, north of Barton under Needwood;

“the works period” means the period starting at 08:00 hours on Monday 13th August 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to Barton Service Road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of 3 shall not apply to –

- (i) any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
- (ii) any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform;
- (iii) personnel engaged in the said works; or
- (iv) any person proceeding in the footway to or from premises which are accessible for that person from, and only from, that footway.
