**The A46 Trunk Road (Groby to Anstey, Leicestershire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 10th August 2012

Coming into force - - 17th August 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads, between Groby and Anstey in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Groby to Anstey, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 17th August 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A50 and Leicester Road near Groby to its junction with the entry slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A5630, Leicester Road and Gynsill Lane, near Anstey;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading –

- (i) to northbound carriageway of the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A50 and Leicester Road near Groby; and
- (ii) from the northbound carriageway of the A46 to its roundabout junction with the A5630, Leicester Road and Gynsill Road, near Anstey;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

“the works period”

means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 20th August 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
