**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A303 Trunk Road (Longbarrow Roundabout, Wiltshire)  
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 22nd August 2012

*Coming into force* - - 1st September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A303 Trunk Road (“the A303”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Stonehenge in Wiltshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A303 Trunk Road (Longbarrow Roundabout, Wiltshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st September 2012.

2. In this Order -

“the A303” means the A303 near Stonehenge from the centre of its junction with the B3083 at Winterbourne Stoke to the centre of its junction with the A344;

“the works” mean roundabout improvement works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 3rd September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the A303.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the A303 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:

- (i) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) a vehicle being used at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
