**The A3 Trunk Road (Liss to Ham Barn Roundabout)
(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *10th September 2012*

Coming into force - - *1st October 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road, is satisfied that pedestrians and cyclists using the footpath/ cycle path adjacent to the trunk road in the County of Hampshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Liss to Ham Barn Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st October 2012.

2. In this Order;

“the trunk road” means the A3 Trunk Road;

“works” means highway maintenance;

“the works period” means a period starting at 0000 hours on Monday 1st October 2012 and ending at 2359 hours on Friday 30th November 2012. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 6 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the footway” means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot;

“the cycleway” means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way by bicycle;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no pedestrian or cyclist shall enter or proceed in the footway or cycleway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any person employed by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services who needs access for emergency purposes, any person engaged in the works, or traffic officers, or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
