**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A1 Trunk Road (Barrowby to Gonerby Moor, Lincolnshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 28th August 2012

*Coming into force* - - 4th September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, between Barrowby and Gonerby Moor in the County of Lincolnshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Barrowby to Gonerby Moor, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 4th September 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road”	means the northbound carriageway of the A1 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A52 at Barrowby to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the B1174 at Gonerby Moor;
“the slip road”	means slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A1 at Barrowby;
“the works period”	means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 8th September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (d) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
