ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A5 Trunk Road (Wall to Muckley Corner, Staffordshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 29th August 2012

Coming into force - - 5th September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Wall and Muckley Corner in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Wall to Muckley Corner, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 5th September 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the westbound carriageway of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the A5127 and A5148 (Wall Interchange) to its roundabout junction with the A461 at Muckley Corner;

“the works period” means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Wednesday 12th September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A5 at its junction with Cranebrook Lane.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –
- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
 - (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
 - (d) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
