ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junction 11) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2012

Made - - - - 3rd September 2012

Coming into force - - 10th September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway (“the M6”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 11) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 10th September 2012.

2. In this Order:

“a slip road” means –
i) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 11; and
ii) the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 11;

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A460 at its roundabout junction with the A462 and the slip roads leading to and from the M6 at Junction 11;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 17th September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to the northern side of the roundabout.

5. The provisions of –

- (a) article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
 - (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform; and
- (b) article 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to –
 - (i) any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
 - (ii) any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (iii) personnel engaged in the said works.
