**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A49 Trunk Road (Ludlow, Shropshire) (Temporary  
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 23rd January 2012

*Coming into force* - - 30th January 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Ludlow in the County of Shropshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A49 Trunk Road (Ludlow, Shropshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 30th January 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A49 between a point 440 metres north and a point 301 metres south of its junction with the B4361 Overton Road;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 6th February 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 40 miles per hour on the trunk road; and
- (b) 10 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) being used for special forces purposes; or
- (iii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
