**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A663 Trunk Road (Whitegate Lane to Jardine Way)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *1st October 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *16th October 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A663 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road in the District of Oldham in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A663 Trunk Road (Whitegate Lane to Jardine Way) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 16th October 2012.
2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A663 Trunk Road;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Wednesday 17 October 2012 and ending on Wednesday 31 October 2012. However, works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means renewal of high friction surfacing on junction approaches, road marking renewal and other general small works maintenance on the trunk road.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any motor vehicle to make a right turn from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road onto Whitegate Lane.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order no person shall during the works period cause or permit any motor vehicle to make a right turn from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road onto Jardine Way.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or to vehicles being used for works purposes or by traffic officers, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
