ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 and A49 Trunk Roads (Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - *1st October 2012*
Coming into force - - *8th October 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”) and the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads, in the County of Shropshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 and A49 Trunk Roads (Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th October 2012.

2. In this Order:

- “the trunk road” means –
- (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the A458 (Churncote Roundabout) to its roundabout junction with the A49 and A5112 (Bailey’s Roundabout);
 - (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the A49 and A5112 (Bailey’s Roundabout) to its roundabout junction with the B4386 (Woodcote Roundabout);
- “bus stop area” means any area of a carriageway on a side of the trunk road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025, 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b);

“the works period”

means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 15th October 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the bus stop area situated adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A49 20 metres south of its roundabout junction with the A5 and A5112.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
