ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Clay Lane Junction to Drumbridges Junction, Devon) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - - *24th October 2012*
Coming into force - - - *27th October 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads near Chudleigh in the District of Teignbridge in the County of Devon should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Clay Lane Junction to Drumbridges Junction, Devon) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 27th October 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of the A38” means the westbound carriageway of the A38 from a point 1500 metres east of the centre of the Clay Lane Junction Overbridge to a point at the centre of the Drumbridges Junction;

“the second length of the A38” means the westbound carriageway of the A38 from a point 500 metres east of the centre of the Clay Lane Junction Overbridge to a point at the centre of the Drumbridges Junction;

“the slip road” means the westbound entry slip road at the A38 Clay Lane Junction;

“the local road” means the side road to Teigngrace leading to and from the A38;

“the works” mean resurfacing and other maintenance works;

“a works period” means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Monday 29th October 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4, 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period:

- (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the first length of the A38 and the slip road;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the second length of the A38 and the slip road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed;
- (c) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road;
- (d) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A38 at its junction with the local road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

5. The provisions of articles 3(c) and (d) shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
