The A120 Trunk Road (Coggeshall Bypass, Essex) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012

Made - - - - *5th November 2012*

Coming into force - - *17th November 2012*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the A120 Trunk Road (Coggeshall Bypass, Essex) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 17th November 2012.

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on a length of the A120 Trunk Road in the District of Braintree in the County of Essex between points 475 metres east of the centre line of its northern junction and 450 metres west of the centre line of its southern junction, with the B1024 Colne Road, Coggeshall, a distance of 975 metres.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall not apply to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order will impose a speed limit of 50 miles per hour on the A120 Trunk Road, Coggeshall Bypass, to improve safety on the approaches to the B1024 Colne Road junction.
