ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Cannock, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 6th November 2012

Coming into force - - 13th November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, south of Cannock in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Cannock, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 13th November 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the works period” means the period starting at 19.00 hours on Tuesday 20th November 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A5 trunk road at its junction with –

- i) North Street;
- ii) New Street; and
- iii) Walkmill Lane.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provision of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;

- (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (d) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
