**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M4 Motorway (Junction 6, Slip Roads) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *12th November 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *1st December 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M4 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M4 Motorway (Junction 6, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st December 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M4 Motorway in the Borough of Slough;

“a slip road” means –

- (i) the road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6 (A355),
- (ii) the road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6 (A355),
- (iii) the road leading to the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6 (A355), or
- (iv) the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6 (A355);

“works” means carriageway repairs and all other associated works on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 3rd December 2012 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 6½ hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 7th December 2012 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 9 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 8th December 2012 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 6½ hours starting at 2300 hours on Sunday 9th December 2012 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 31st May 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) any vehicle being used for incident management purposes.
