**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road (Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made - - - - 19th November 2012*

*Coming into force - - 26th November 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Atherstone in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th November 2012.

2. In this Order:

| “the trunk road”          | means the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the B4116 (Holly Lane and Merevale Lane) to its roundabout junction with the B4111, B4116 and Carlyon Road at Atherstone; |
| “the central reservation” | means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road;  |
| “the works period”        | means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Friday 30th November 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;   |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation of the trunk road opposite its junction with Merevale Road;

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
