**The A628 Trunk Road (Crowden Brook Bridge) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *2nd February 2012*

Coming into force - - *11th February 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A628 Trunk Road, in the County of Derbyshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because bridge maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A628 Trunk Road (Crowden Brook Bridge) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 11th February 2012.

2. In this Order;

“the A628” means the A628 Trunk Road;

“the first length of trunk road” means the A628 from a point 200 metres east of the centreline of Crowden Brook Bridge to a point 290 metres west of the centreline of Crowden Brook Bridge, a distance of approximately 490 metres;

“the second length of trunk road” means the A628 from the centreline of its junction with the B6105 westwards for a distance of 5700 metres;

“the first works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Sunday 12th February 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

“the second works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Sunday 12th February 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the first works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the second works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for the purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article;

and nothing in article 4 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A628 Trunk Road to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.

6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
