**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Dobwalls Bypass, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 28th November 2012

*Coming into force* - - 1st December 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Dobwalls in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Dobwalls Bypass, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st December 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the A38” means the eastbound carriageway of the A38 Dobwalls Bypass from the eastern edge of Twelvewoods Roundabout to the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road at the Looe Mills Junction;

“tip of the nosing” means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road;

“the works” mean pavement investigation and remedial works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 3rd December 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A38.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
