**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (South of Coventry) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 26th November 2012

*Coming into force* - - 3rd December 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road and on one of those connecting roads, in the City of Coventry and the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (South of Coventry) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 3rd December 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the roundabout”	means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A45, the A46 and the A444, known as Festival Island;
“the slip road”	means the slip road leading to the roundabout from the eastbound carriageway of the A45;
“the works period”	means the period starting at 20:00 hours on December 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the north western section of the roundabout between the junction with the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A45 and the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A444.

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4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the first length of roundabout at the junction with Leaf Lane.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(iii) being used in connection with the said works.
