**The A46 Trunk Road (Sedgeberrow, Worcestershire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *4th December 2012*

Coming into force - - *11th December 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Sedgeberrow in the County of Worcestershire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A46 Trunk Road (Sedgeberrow, Worcestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 11th December 2012.

2. In this Order:
“the trunk road” means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A46 between a point 300 metres east of, and 800 metres west of, the centreline of its junction with Sandfield Lane;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the period starting at 00.01 hours on Tuesday 18th December 2012 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake a moving vehicle in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
