**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M42 Motorway (Junction 9, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 27th January 2012  
*Coming into force* - - 3rd February 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway (“the M42”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of the roundabout at M42 Junction 9, near Curdworth, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junction 9, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 3rd February 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A446 roundabout at M42 Junction 9;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 6th February 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the southern sector of the roundabout between the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M42 and the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M42.

4. The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
  - (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
