**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Tideford, Cornwall) (Temporary  
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *22nd February 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *25th February 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Tideford in Cornwall should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Tideford, Cornwall) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 25th February 2012.

**2.** In this Order –

“the A38” means the A38 from a point 185 metres west of the centre of its junction with Bridge Road at Tideford to a point 300 metres east of the centre of its junction with the C0262 Tredinnick Lane;

“bus” has the meaning given in regulation 22(2) of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b);

“bus stop area” means an area of carriageway on a side of the trunk road or a slip road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025 [1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4] in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002;

“the works” mean improvement and maintenance works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Sunday 26th February 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

“a works period” means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Sunday 26th February 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the A38.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the bus stop area situated:

- (a) adjacent to the A38 eastbound situated 80 metres east of the centre of its junction with Bridge Road, Tidedford;
- (b) adjacent to the A38 westbound situated 150 metres east of the centre of its junction with Bridge Road, Tidedford.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.

7. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
