**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (Ryton-on-Dunsmore to Blue Boar,  
Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *24th February 2012*  
*Coming into force* - - *2nd March 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Ryton-on-Dunsmore and Blue Boar in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Ryton-on-Dunsmore to Blue Boar, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A45, including the circulatory carriageway of its roundabout junction with the B4453 (Memorial Roundabout), between its roundabout junction with the A445 at Ryton-on-Dunsmore and its junction with the A4071 (Blue Boar).

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 3rd March 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (d) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
