ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Thornhaugh, Peterborough) (Closure of Gap in the Central Reservation) Order 2012

Made - - - - - *14th March 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *28th March 2012*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Thornhaugh, Peterborough) (Closure of Gap in the Central Reservation) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 28th March 2012.

2. In this Order -

“the trunk road” means the A1 Trunk Road in the City of Peterborough;

“central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates the carriageway to be used by vehicles travelling in one direction from the carriageway to be used by vehicles travelling in the opposite direction.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation opposite the junction of the trunk road with Russell Hill leading to Thornhaugh.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order will permanently close the gap in the central reservation located opposite the junction of the A1 with Russell Hill, to reduce the risk of accidents at this junction.
