**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bournemouth)
Regulations 2013**

Made - - - - - *9th May 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *29th August 2013*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Bournemouth, Dorset by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place during the period from 29th August to 1st September 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bournemouth) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 29th August 2013.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (3)—

- (a) between 1200 hours and 2000 hours on 29th and 30th August 2013,
- (b) between 1100 hours and 2000 hours on 31st August 2013, and
- (c) between 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 1st September 2013,

no aircraft is to fly below 5,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by straight lines joining successively the points referred to in paragraph (2).

(2) The points mentioned in paragraph (1) are—

- (a) 504304N 0015636W,
- (b) 504405N 0014703W,
- (c) 504016N 0014604W,
- (d) 503914N 0015537W, and
- (e) 504304N 0015636W.

(a) S.I. 2009/3015, to which there are amendments that are not relevant to these Regulations.

- (3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying—
- (a) in accordance with a clearance issued by the air traffic control unit at either Bournemouth Airport or Southampton Airport, or
 - (b) with the permission of the flying display director for the Bournemouth Air Festival.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of the seafront at Bournemouth, Dorset during the Bournemouth Air Festival which will take place between 29th August and 1st September 2013. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the Air Festival. The Civil Aviation Authority's Safety Regulation Group and Directorate of Airspace Policy, with the agreement of the Department for Transport, consider that flying should be restricted during the air show in the vicinity of Bournemouth for reasons of public safety.

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(3)(b), the Bournemouth Air Festival flying display director may be contacted on telephone 07979 593941.

Full details of the airspace restrictions will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
