## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A516 and A38 Trunk Roads (Mickleover, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 25th March 2013

 Coming into force
 1st April 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A516 Trunk Road ("the A516"), the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads and one of those connecting roads near Mickleover in the County of Derbyshire should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A516 and A38 Trunk Roads (Mickleover, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 1st April 2013.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the first length of trunk road" means the northbound carriageway of the A516 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction with Etwall Road and Ladybank Road to its junction with the northbound carriageway of the A38; "the second length of trunk road" means the northbound carriageway of the A516 from a point 1000 metres south of its junction with the slip road, to its junction with that slip road; "the third length of trunk road" means the northbound carriageway of the A38 from a point 1000 metres south of its junction with the A516 to that junction; "the slip road" means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A516 from its roundabout junction Etwall Road and Ladybank Road;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 8th April 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of trunk road or the slip road.
- **4**. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the second length of trunk road or the third length of trunk road.
- **5.** The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - **6.** The provisions of
    - (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle
      - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
      - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
    - (b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
    - (c) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
